Captain	Dobbs, Joseph David	WD - died 8 Jun	12th Field Regt	11 Bty FOO	Pg 47, & 145 of unit history says Capt Dobbs was wounded on the PM of 7 June and later died, on 8 Jun 44. WD confirms died of wounds on 8 June. Part II Orders, 12th Fd Regt, No 32, para 2.(c) dated 23 Jun 44, lists him as <i>deceased with effect 8 June 44 (died of wounds)</i> .
Gunner	Taylor, Robert Foubister	WD - died 7 Jun	13th Field Regt	44 Bty, BCs Sig	He was Maj Young's Sig, both mortally wounded by shellfire on run in. He was fished out by navy, and cas evac'd to England. Maj Young was not. WD indicates KIA 06 June, Part II orders No 27, para 6.(e) dated 14 Jun 44, lists him as <i>deceased with effect 07 June 44 (died of wounds)</i>
